Bede Ramcharan, FACHE, FHHI (USA, Medical Service Corps, Retired) founded Indatatech in 2000. He retired in 2000 as a Service-Disabled Veteran.

He is a parachutist, and has been awarded numerous medals and honors. He was selected for a Congressional Fellowship with the Brookings Institute, and worked on the personal staff of Congressman James Clyburn (SC) where he advised the Congressman on healthcare and military issues.
