Bridging the Gap from Injury Site to MEDEVAC



The Pocket Litter is a rapidly deployable emergency evacuation stretcher that fits in the cargo pocket of the operator.

- Bridges the gap between the site of injury and traditional non-ambulatory transport of a patient
- Individual (1 on 1) drag out of the area, or traditional 2-6 man carry
- 3 tie downs to secure the patient to the stretcher
- Carry size: 6x9.25x1.75"
- Lightweight < <33 oz.
- Spine support
- Rapidly employed <10 seconds
- Simple employment, no training is needed
- Individual operators carried items, or multiple operators on the mission
- The stretcher is no longer cached at the ORP
- Multiple use-material
- Hydrophobic, chemical resistant materials
